

COMPETENT CREW COURSE

This 4-day course covers practical sailing and certain theory aspects. At the end of the course candidates should have sufficient knowledge and experience about crewing and be able to safely take control of a yacht if required. This forms the first 4-days of the full 9-day Day Skipper course.

- Those wanting to try a new sport and develop new skills
- Establishing whether yachting is a career or gap year opportunity you may wish to pursue
- Candidates pursuing a Day Skippers Ticket, but want to split the course in two parts
